## Primary Call-Outs Have Begun at EDCF



The Chaplain's at EDCF are excited to announce that religious call-outs are finally opening back up!! Starting on Monday, October 17, we will begin offering religious programming at the EDCF Spiritual Life Center for the first time in 14 months! As we anticipated, we are only allowed to have "Primary" call-outs to start with and those call-outs are being limited to 20 residents at a time. As such, we will be having Christian Praise and Worship Service every weeknight from 6-7 pm. If you are a trained volunteer and want to begin participating in these services, you need to arrive at the facility by 5:30 pm to be processed and in the facility in time for services to begin.

Previously the Praise & Worship Service was held on Sunday evenings and has always been our most attended call-out in the facility. It is my hope and desire that volunteers that previously led different Bible Studies throughout the week will choose to come back and participate in the service on the evening they choose. That would mean, if you used to be involved in the CKPM Bible Study that took place every Tuesday evening, I would encourage you to begin attending service on Tuesday nights or whatever night(s) work best for you. This would give you the opportunity to get to know the men attending services and hopefully very soon we can get back to "normal" programming and you would already have formed ministry relationships with men that would potentially be attending your Bible Study group.

We are blessed to have volunteers that have patiently waited to come back into the facility. We are grateful that the time has come that we can begin to open the doors again to the men here at EDCF and that you are all excited to be partners in ministry here. ## Spiritual Life Center Technology Update

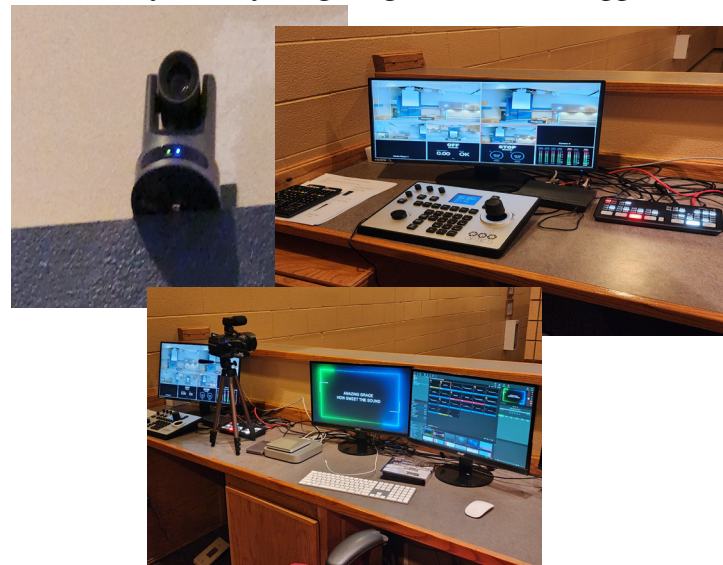

## Tis the Season for Sharing

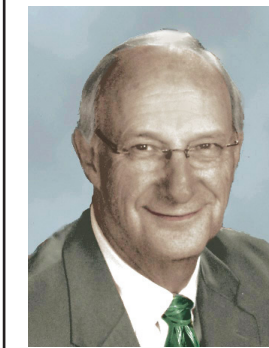

I look forward to being with family, gathering around the table, sharing gifts, and reflecting on the year while looking forward to what the new year will bring. For those incarcerated, their experience around this time of year is different. For many years CKPM and partners have been able to bless those without the same privileges by sharing a package with as many as funds will allow to bless with goodies, hygiene items, Scripture booklet and a note of encouragement.

If a resident is not a worker, porter, or employed they struggle to have even the basic items as the rest of the population, and are thus “indigent”. The men we provide packages to are in the infirmary, segregation, disabled, or unable to get a job. CKPM’s focus of special gifts for this effort has gone primarily to share a package with the indigent population at EDCF. We are planning to bless the EDCF indigent population with a Christmas package again this year.

We are happy to assist the efforts to provide packages for the population of other Kansas prisons as well. We are thankful for funds to CKPM for this effort and for the churches and individuals who have coordinated and provided packages to other Kansas prison populations.

Last year all of Winfield, Hutchinson, and EDCF residents received packages. The EDCF SLC Fund provided packages for all the residents there. We are grateful for the support and giving toward these endeavors and for those who helped to package and deliver! We ask you prayerfully consider a special gift to CKPM for these efforts.
